



Birkenhead United AFC presents LOTTO 10th Grade 9-a-side Tournament September 2010

LOTTO in partnership with Birkenhead United AFC invites clubs to enter a team into the LOTTO 10th grade 9-a-side tournament to be held over a two day duration:

When: Saturday 11th & Sunday 12th September 2010

Where: Shepherds Park, Melba Street, Beachhaven, Auckland

Entry fee: \$150 per team

Entry restriction: Restricted to a limited number of teams. Entries accepted on first paid basis. All teams to be from NZ Football Federation affiliated clubs. No school teams, regional selection teams or area selection teams will be accepted. Entries must be received by Friday 20th August 2010.

- Games will be played on half size fields, with 9 players per team on the field (including a goalkeeper), using the supplied 4m x 2m goals (with proportional size penalty box) and size 4 ball.
- Teams will be limited to a squad of 12 registered players. There will be unlimited number of rolling substitutes allowed during games.
- For the 10th grade boys the players must be born no earlier than 1 January 2000. Copy of proof of age for a player is to be submitted upon request of tournament organiser.
- There will be no dispensation by age for boys. Girls may play if born no earlier than 1 January 1999.
- Entries for more than one team per club will be accepted at the discretion of the Tournament Organiser and subject to the number of confirmed team entries received prior to 20th August. If you are entering multiple teams, please rank your teams.
- If there are enough entries from Girl only teams we will form a separate league for girls only teams.
- Teams will be grouped (dependent on entry numbers) so that on Day One they play other teams in group. Day two will be the knockout stage (involving quarter finals, semi finals and finals) which will involve all teams initially until knocked out. We will form a Tournament section and a Plate section for the Knockout Finals series. First games each day could start as early as 9:00am. Full details of the tournament rules and the draw for each day will be distributed to teams prior to the tournament.
- Hot and cold food will be on sale throughout the tournament. There is also plenty of space to erect your team tents.
