Note:

- Games will be played on half size fields, with 7 players per team on the field with one a goalkeeper, using 3.2m x 1.6m goals with an 11th Grade Size 4 Ball
- First games kick off at 9.00am but please check the final draw for game times.
- Teams will be limited to 10 registered players.
- Only players born in 1999 or later (11th Grade)
- There will be no dispensated players (except girls may play one year below age).
- We will accept entries for more than one team per club. If entering multiple teams, please rank your teams.
- All teams will play a minimum of 3 games.
- There are prizes for the finalists in both the Plate and Consolation Knockout sections of the competition.
- Hot and cold food will be on sale throughout the tournament.

Details of the rules and draw will be in the coaches' packs distributed at the tournament and emailed to the team contact person prior to tournament day. Please include your contact person details on the entry form below to make sure the packs go to the right person.

General

- Time keeping for the pool games is the responsibility of the host club. All pool games will start and stop on the hooter. Quarter, Semi and Finals will be to the Referees time keeping. Please be ready with your team to go on as soon as the previous game has finished.
- Referees will be supplied by the host club for Semi and Finals. If referee is unavailable then teams to referee half a game each and return score card to the administration desk
- 7 a side with 3 subs; one of the 7 players is a goalkeeper
- Size 4 balls will be provided by the host club. Games are played on half fields with 3.2m x 1.6m goals.
- Scoring for pool games is 3 for a win, 1 for a draw

Postponement / Cancellation

- In the event of a postponement because of bad weather, the tournament will be rescheduled to the earliest date grounds are available – typically on Sunday the week following the originally scheduled date.
- If weather causes the 2nd scheduled date to be abandoned, the tournament will be cancelled and half the entrance fee will be refunded.

Rules

- FIFA rules will apply including offside
- NO DISPENSATED PLAYERS (except girls may play one year below age).
- No spectators allowed around goals or on field (including halfway line of the full field).
- Boots and shin pads must be worn by all players.
- Any team not on the field for the hooter start will be disqualified for that game.
- The referee's decision is final, apart from the time keeping in pool games.
- Rolling subs (only during stoppages in play)
- Corner kicks to be taken from corner flag.
- Goal kicks may be taken by kicking it from the hand or placing the ball on the ground 5 metres out from the goal and kicking it from there.

Prizes

Tournament – winners receive medals and certificates, runner-ups receive certificates
Plate round – winners receive medals and certificates, runner-ups receive certificates
Consolation Plate round – winners and runner-ups receive certificates

Pool Play

- 12.5 minutes each way - 2 minutes half time
- In the event of even points at the end of pool play
- Time controlled by hooter

1. Highest goal difference
2. Goals For
3. Goals Against
4. Head to Head Result

Quarter and Semi Finals

- 15 minutes each way - 2 minutes half time
- Time controlled by Referee

In the event of a tie in the semi finals:

1. 5 minutes extra time each way with Golden goal.
2. Penalty shoot out with 5 nominated players (10 yards from goal).
3. Sudden death penalty shoot out with any remaining players.
4. If still tied then decided by toss of a coin.

Finals

- 20 minutes each way - 3 minute half time
- Controlled by Referee and Linesmen

In event of a tie in the finals:

1. 5 minutes extra time each way with Golden goal.
2. Penalty shoot out with 5 nominated players (10m from goal).
3. Sudden death penalty shoot out with any remaining players.
4. If still tied then decided by toss of a coin.
