Personnel Specifications

Suitable applicants would have coaching qualifications in Football, preferably with experience in a College or Youth environment. Applicants would be expected to work with the team of people delivering the expectations for the football at the school.

Premier and competitive athletes require high quality coaches with special interest in youth sport who can balance the dual objectives of success in the immediate season with the long-term development of individual athletes within team environments.

Knowledge and Experience

- Successful coaching experience.
- Relevant and extensive knowledge of the demands of college sport, and requirements of sport at youth elite level.
- Completed appropriate relevant sport coaching qualifications from their national sporting organisation. First aid qualifications would be desirable.
- Police vetting is required

Personal Attributes

- Able to plan, lead, and deliver a team programme to meet set objectives.
- Able to express ideas and information clearly, and perform and demonstrate or instruct all skills and activities to a high level.
- Able to gather information, hear what others are saying, and understand content in relation to coaching and use appropriate **technology including video analysis** as coaching aid.
- Able to motivate and enthuse the athletes, lead an effective pre-season work with team support staff
- Be success driven
- Able to track individual athlete and team progress towards objectives, ensures standards are being complied with, and takes action when variances from plans or standards are identified.
- Presents themselves in a way that creates good role models for school and code
- Be able to work closely with TIC of Netball, Netball Coordinator and strength & conditioning staff

This role in some cases will carry remuneration or other incentives and support.

Hours would generally be a minimum of 6 -8 hours per week and will be negotiated for the preferred candidate for the role. It is expected that the coach would be in attendance at all games and training sessions
